Summer is approaching: some things to keep in mind.

- **Tumbleweeds** can be easily removed now while they are still young and before they seed by simply pulling the plants up by their roots. Also remove any mature tumbleweeds if they blow into your yard as they drop seeds as they roll around.
- Lot Watering: During the coming peak summer months, please alternate your water use to reduce the impact on our water system. Odd Numbered Lots to water on odd numbered calendar days. Even Numbered Lots to water on even numbered calendar days! Use your Lot number, not your Address number. Lot numbers are on your Water Bill.
