His comments follow, "We have looked at the newly sealed cracks that have settled a bit and that have caused concern. Our assessment is that nothing out of the ordinary is occurring. The product is pliable and is made to flex and bend with the conditions (i.e. ground shifts, movement, heat/cold swings) and with this structural make-up comes some settlement. Even though some cracks are settling, they are still sealed at the bottom and the sealant is effective. Please let us know if there are any further concerns that need to be addressed."
