During the summer dry months, we ask that you restrict any heavy lot watering to reduce the impact on our water system as follows: Alternate your water use. **Odd Numbered Lots** to water on odd numbered calendar days. **Even Numbered Lots** to water on even numbered calendar days! Use your **Lot** number, not your **Address** number. Lot numbers are on your **Water Bill**.
