

President's message for July 2022:

Welcome to SUMMER. Once it arrived, it came at once with hot dry weather. With that comes the fire danger that is ever prevalent in Central Oregon. We ask that you trim the lower limbs of your trees up to a minimum height of four feet, cut your underbrush and cheatgrass to mitigate the "ladder fuels' if a fire should occur and run through the neighborhood.

We recently had a pump failure with well #1 and are pumping from well #2 and #3 to fill the other two cisterns. We put out a notification requesting a volunteer water use restriction until we are able to fully assess the failure. We learned that we would have to replace the pump in well #1, and will do so as quickly as possible, but it will take several more days for the contractor to get the correct pump and then installation of the pump. Allen Dendy, our head Water master and other volunteers, are diligently working on this to get it replaced as soon as possible. So please attempt to conserve water as much as possible until we get this issue resolved.

Also, I want to thank the Volunteers who put forth their time and effort in making our community one of the best around. **Enjoy your summer.**
