Levels for wildfires evacuation. Level 1 – Be ready for potential evacuation. Level 2 – Be set to evacuate at a moment's notice. Level 3 – Evacuate now. Leave immediately. Have a go bag ready with all your important papers and make sure your pets are available for evacuation also.
