- A reminder from your Watermaster: PLEASE DO NOT USE FIBERGLASS INSULATION IN THE METER BOXES. It absorbs water and then it freezes.
- Thank you everyone who received and read their backflow device report and letter from the Board recently, and an especially BIG thank you to those who took action to correct any problems with their own backflow. Of the ten that failed their test in October, all but one homeowner have either fixed theirs or arranged to have Burris Plumbing come out and repair and retest. Your HOA pays for the testing each year, and the cost of that this year was \$7,740.00. Each test costs \$60.00. For the sake of your neighbors and community, it is imperative these backflow devices operate correctly, and since they are on your property, it is your responsibility to make any necessary repairs if something comes up. If you don't assume responsibility for fixing your backflow, we may be forced to terminate your water service, and no one wants that! This is a State of Oregon Law.
- Volunteers continue, weather permitting, to clear the trimmed tree branches at the office, and it is looking good! Another improvement to the office is addition of safety asphalt tarp that was screwed down on top of the ramp and stairs, and a temporary repair of the gutters that were leaking and dropping water and then freezing in front of the doors. Those gutters are in need of replacement; they are PVC material and worn out. That will be a project for next year.
- When driving, be mindful of slick roads when the snow does start falling. Hopefully no one has any accidents. Watch out for deer as well as they are out trying to find food the colder it gets.
