UPCOMING BOARD MEETINGS February 8 March 14

- This is a good time to check your yard and home for any possible breaks or leaks in your water lines or plumbing as a result of the extremely cold, icy, freezing weather we had recently as well. **We will begin reading the meters again on April 1st**, and that is when some homeowners are surprised by a large bill that is the result of a broken line somewhere or a leak. If you find a problem now, it can save you money (and a surprise) to get it repaired before April 1st.
- **Our Annual Meeting is coming up**. We are tentatively planning the annual HOA meeting for Saturday, May 4th, again at the Crook County Library at 1:00 pm. We encourage you to attend as we will be discussing fee raises to help boost our Reserve Savings which is used for major projects, like water system issues with cistern problems and well problems. Also, as our roads in High Desert Estates are NOT county owned or maintained, it is our financial responsibility to keep them in good shape, and in 2022 we had some work done and that was around \$25,000.00, and this Spring we need to have more done to the roads that weren't done in 2023, at a possible cost of \$23,000.00. To have an understanding of why we need the Reserve Savings for future expenditures, please come to our meeting this May as we will explain it all and will be laying out our 25 year plan.
- Each month, as you know, everyone gets a water bill either mailed or emailed to them. We mail out 113 bills at a cost per stamp now of 68 cents each, so that cost is \$76.84. The remaining 49 bills are sent out by email. If you currently get your bill in the mail and would prefer your bill to be emailed, and it would save our HOA some money each month, you can definitely let us know by emailing us at HDEHOA172@gmail.com. The emailed bills all have the newsletter included as an attachment to your bill.
