- We are again having reports of loose dogs running around the HOA and this is especially dangerous for those of us who walk our own dog and are being approached by loose dogs. Please keep your dog under control on your own property, or on a leash when walking. There have been a few incidents in the past when loose dogs attack a walker's dog, or the walker themselves. If someone gets hurt, you could be responsible for medical bills for the dog or walker. Nobody wants to get hurt or watch their dog get attacked.


